
DAY 08

Documents you may want to provide - all visitors

Previous travel documents/passports, which show previous travel.

Financial documents showing that you have sufficient funds available.

These must clearly show that you have access to the funds, such as:

- Bank statements
- Proof of earnings such as a letter from employer confirming employment details (start date of employment, salary, role, company contact details)
- Confirmation of legal residence, if you are not a national of the country in which you are applying or your right to reside there is not included in your passport.

Details of employment or studies where you have stated in your application that you are either employed or in full-time studies.

This could include:

- A letter from your employer on company headed paper, detailing your role, salary and length of employment
- A letter from your education provider, on headed paper, confirming your enrolment and leave of absence

If self employed: business registration documents confirming the business owner's name and the date the business started trading.

Documents requested

- If you are applying as a family/group you do not need to provide multiple copies of the same documents
- Bank statements or letters issued more than 1 year before the date of application
- Driving licence
- Photographs (other than passport photographs required in section 1)
- Notarial certificates

Visas (USA & Canada Citizens only)

EAST AFRICA (Kenya, Rwanda and Uganda)

A visa is required for travel to Kenva

An East Africa visa is for travel within the Republic of Kenya, Republic of Rwanda and Republic of Uganda; movement is permitted between these three countries with a single visa. If applying for an East Africa visa through the Consulate of Kenya, then Kenya should be the first destination of arrival in East Africa.

Visa fee: \$ 120 (single entry)

TANZANIA

A visa is required for travel to Tanzania

- A valid passport and tourist visa are required to visit Tanzania.
- · One Tanzanian visa application form.
- Two recent, identical, 2 x 2 passport photographs
- Proof of Travel Arrangements (Air Ticket, Hotel)

Visa fee: \$ 125 (single entry)

VISA ON ARRIVAL

It is possible for the applicant to obtain a visa upon arrival. Visa requirements and restrictions vary greatly when obtaining an on arrival visa. Tanzania immigration officials hold the right to refuse entry to anyone for any reason. Travisa strongly recommend that the traveler obtain a visa prior to departure. Should the applicant choose to obtain a visa upon arrival, inquire with your airline if boarding is allowed without a visa.

SOUTH AFRICA

A visa is not required for travel to South Africa

A visa is not required for a stay of up to 90 days. Traveler must be in possession of a passport valid for 6 months beyond stay with two adjacent blank visa pages and a round-trip or onward ticket.

ZAMBIA

• THE NATIONAL AIRPORTS CORPORATION ZAMBIA has introduced a security charge payable at all NACL airports in Zambia. The charge is effective at Lusaka, Livingstone, Ndola and Mfuwe and can be paid at the same time as departure tax. The new security charge is US\$3pp per sector (domestic flights). A US\$5 international security charge has also been implemented (Lusaka and Livingstone), As of 15 June 2013 an Infrastructure and Development (RM) tax will also be levied. For domestic flight sectors the RM tax will be approximately US\$5 per person and for international flight sectors US\$10 per person.

LIVINGSTONE / ZAMBIA VISA

Clients need to secure a visa before travel if they are not exempt. The Zambian Government have recently launched an online e-Visa facility that travellers may use to pre-apply for visas http://evisa.zambiaimmigration.gov.zm/#/. All foreign nationals who require visas are eligible to apply for an e-Visa. Below are the revised charges for entry into Zambia. For nationals that may obtain visas at ports of entry, the e-Visa will take 3 working days to process and for nationals that require visas prior to travel to Zambia, processing time will take a minimum of 5 working days. The e-Visa fees needs to be settled at port of entry when collecting visa. These are current fees and the Zambian Government might change these charges at any time:

Single Entry USD 50-00pp Double Entry USD 80-00pp

IMMUNIZATION

The best choice of vaccines for your trip depends on many individual factors, including your precise travel plans. Vaccines commonly recommended for travelers to Africa include those against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio, Typhoid, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Yellow fever, Malaria Rabies and Meningitis.

Certificate is required for entry into, or travel between, some African countries. Several of these vaccines require more than one dose, or take time to become effective. It is always best to seek advice from your doctor on immunization well in advance, if possible around 6 weeks before departure.

The government of Tanzania requires proof of yellow fever vaccination upon arrival if you are traveling from a country with risk of yellow fever.

For Malaria, talk to your doctor about how to prevent malaria while traveling. You may need to take prescription medicine before, during, and after your trip to prevent malaria, especially if you are visiting low-altitude areas. See more detailed information about malaria in Tanzania.


